The undersigned associations write to you in anticipation of the Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (ANPRM) regarding the review of controls for foundational technologies set forth in the Export Control Reform Act of 2018 (ECRA). We thank you for your efforts to fulfill the essential national security objectives behind the ECRA and your department's willingness to engage with industry throughout this process.

The development of industry input in response to the emerging technologies ANPRM provided a window into the complex dimensions of these proposed policy changes. We thank you for recognizing those challenges and graciously extending the timeframe for interested parties to respond. As we look to the next phase of this project, we request that the Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) set the comment period for the foundational technologies ANPRM to 90 days to ensure our associations and our members have adequate time to review the notice and provide comprehensive feedback to address the policy concerns and technological complexities at issue.

We look forward to working with you and BIS to ensure that the government receives the best input it can from all available sources about foundational technologies as laid out in the ECRA.
